Configuring Oliver

The following parameters are set by navigating to **Management > Parameters** within the Oliver Management Interface

Serials Solutions will supply this information to you as all of these values depend on the 360 Search site that Serials Solutions configures for you.

Parameter **7404** can be left blank as the 360 Search icon is the default federated search icon.

... and will direct you to the website created for you by Serials Solutions.







For version v5 Build 1.


Go to your OPAC and perform any search then click the **Link** button.



Right Click on the highlighted link and select **Copy Shortcut**.




Paste the shortcut into notepad and look for **corporation=**. The entry directly after this will be your Corporation Alias.




For version v5 Build 4 and later.

Go to your OPAC and perform any search then click the **Share** button.



Click the **Copy and Paste Shortcut** link.



Look for **corporation=** in the **URL** at the top of the screen. The entry directly after this will be your Corporation Alias.
