

Oliver v5 – Preparing for your Oliver installation

The following information will assist in preparing for your Oliver installation and should be done before completing the Oliver v5 technical survey:

- 1. Review the <u>Oliver v5 specifications</u>
- Choose your server configuration: <u>Option1</u> (Combined Application and Database Server) or <u>Option 2</u> (Separate Application and Database Servers)
- 3. Note the specifications of your server(s) and confirm they meet the Oliver specifications (Operating system(s), RAM, CPUs)
- Install Microsoft SQL Server (including Management Studio and Reporting Services) and confirm you can access these components. See the following documents for further information:

- 5. Create a Windows account which will be used to run Oliver. This user must have full access to SQL Reporting Services and sufficient permission to run a service. For security best practice, this account should not be enabled for RDP. If using the two server configuration, the account will need to be duplicated on both servers. Keep a note of the credentials.
- 6. Choose and test your remote access method (RDP, VPN and RDP, GoToAssist, other).
- 7. Note the details of your SMTP server and a library email address.
